As you know, our Academy has the obligation to serve the Federal Government on request and we are keenly aware of this issue at the present time. Since your University is very much in the public domain it cannot avoid accepting responsibilities to work with our Federal Government as best it may when called upon to serve. Your statement should go a long way toward clearing the air.
