I was born in a little village near Hanoi by the Red River in North Vietnam.

My parents were traders by boat, so I passed my childhood on the rivers of North Vietnam.

When I was ten years old my father died suddenly. My mother did not follow

did not follow her trading affair but I always continued my courses at elementary school.

At the end of 1946, I was attending high school when the war broke out in Vietnam.

Hanoi was in the war. As all my friends I had to stop my courses. I left Hanoi, the

capital of Viet-Nam, to the field with my family. Seven months later I went back and

saw our house had been demolished by the war. My life was changed completely now. I began

to earn money for my family. The life was very hard when I was eighteen years old.

I became an agent of security (Police Secret) in 1950 and worked far from Hanoi.

Almost every night I had to combat against Communists.

Two years later I was transferred back to Hanoi, so I could continue my courses

at high school every night. I married my wife just before our move to the South in

August 1954.

Now, I live in Saigon, the capital of the Republic of Vietnam, with my wife and

my three children. I am working at the Harbor Police Station of Saigon and still

attending a Law course at the University every night.

In 1956, I was ordered to go to Singapore where I followed a C.I.D. course which

was organized by the English government.

The sport that I prefer best is football, however I am not a good player.
