

R E S O L U T I O N

Noting with satisfaction the success of this Seminar On
Social Research And Problems Of Rural Life In South East Asia
(Saigon, March 1960),

Reflected in the fruitful discussions of the various
documents submitted to the Seminar,

Recommends that in order to derive the maximum benefit
generated by this Seminar the Unesco or other U.N. Agencies
should follow up on this Seminar.

This Follow up may include :

1. The organization of a South East Asia Regional Social
Research Training Center, if possible in conjunction
with existing international institutes (e.g. UNESCO
Research Center on the Social Implications of Indus-
trialization in Southern Asia),
2. The preparation of a booklet dealing with social
research methods and procedures already applied or
applicable to this region,
3. The organization of a system of interchange of methods
and procedures applied as well as studies made by
national and other local research institutes in the
countries of this region.
