The team of four has completed its report and today we finish our conversations with American officials here on it. I have airmailed a copy of it to Prof. Ralph Smucker so that the Governmental Research Bureau could mimeograph it immediately. He will present you with a copy as soon as it is available.

I would very much like to meet with you concerning our mission and the report on Friday morning, Oct. 29. There are a number of problems concerning implementation that need to be discussed. Afterwards, in more leisurely fashion the following week, perhaps you would like to meet with the entire team to go over the various parts of the

report in some detail. The Political Science Office will call concerning a definite time for an appointment for me on Friday.

We believe our stay here has been a profitable one from all standpoints - officially and personally. It now remains for us to help push for implementation in the immediate future, even after we return to the States.
