ATTENTION FOR PURPOSES OF LAND TO THE TILLER PROGRAM
OF THE GOVERNMENT

The Minister of Land Reform and Agriculture

I understand that you are interested in the Government's Land-to-the-Tiller Program. This program is designed to help farmers acquire ownership of land that has been expropriated from the former French owners. The program is open to all farmers who are currently tilling the land. The Government will provide the land to the farmer at a price that is based on the value of the land at the time of expropriation. The price will be paid in 12 annual installments. The Government will also provide the farmer with the necessary assistance to help him or her get started on the land.

The official period for the registration of land is from 1961 to 1963. The land must be registered in the name of the farmer who is currently tilling the land. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Village Administrative Committee is the body responsible for the implementation of the Land-to-the-Tiller Program. The Committee is composed of representatives of the Government and the farmers in the village. The Committee will provide the farmer with the necessary assistance to help him or her get started on the land. The Committee will also provide the farmer with the necessary information about the program. The Committee will be happy to answer any questions you may have.

Useful information about the Government's Land-to-the-Tiller program:

1. All expropriated and former French lands are to be distributed to farmers for ownership. Anybody who is tilling a parcel is entitled to purchase it. Come to apply at the Office of the Village where the land is located.
2. When making application, applicant will not be required to pay rent or advance money, or be put in a difficult position. All Village Administrative Committees will provide farmers with ready assistance.
3. Farmers purchasing government owned land will receive permanent ownership titles, nobody can take them back by force.
4. All expenses for delivering titles will be born by the Government. Farmers are required only to pay the price of land, in 12 annual installments.
