On the instruction of the Ambassador, I am pleased to forward to you information on the activities of the Industrial Development Center from its creation through December 1959, which we have just received from Saigon.

A) Amount of loans provided by the Industrial Development Center to various industries in Viet-Nam

Funds from American Aid: VN\$109,000,000

Funds from Vietnamese Budget: VN\$ 39,000,000.

The industries receiving the most important loans are: spinning mills, paper mills, glass industry, sugar mills and pharmaceutical products factories.

B) Amount of funds which the Industrial Development Center brought to various industries as stockholder:

Funds from Vietnamese Budget: VN\$ 124,650,000
