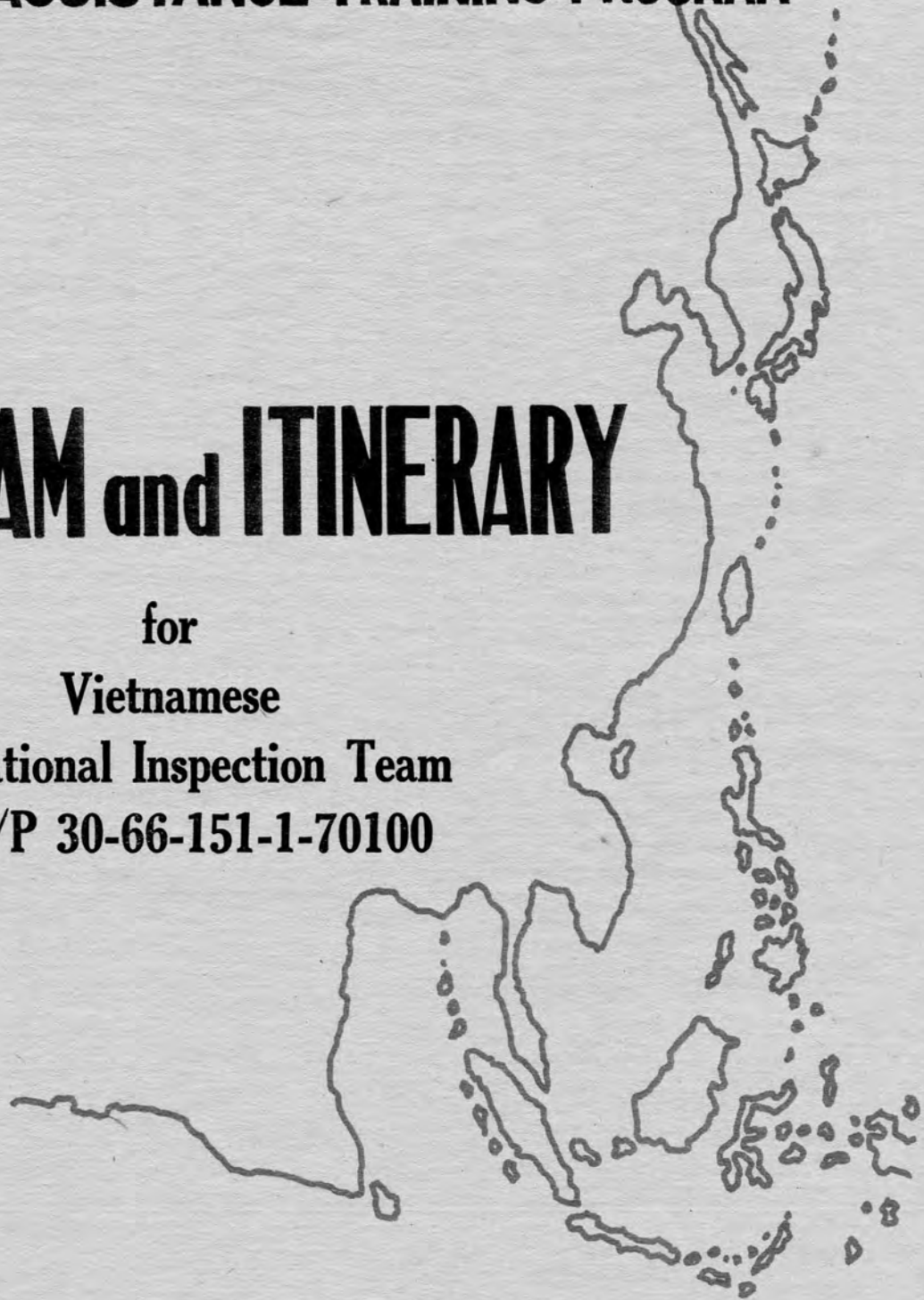

OBJECTIVES

To provide an opportunity for Vietnamese officials to study and observe the educational system and facilities in Japan. It is the opinion of the sponsors of this program that information available on the educational system in Japan could be adapted in Vietnam. The knowledge and information acquired by the participants will be disseminated through practical training and instruction to personnel under their direction and guidance.

The objectives of this Educational Inspection Team are:

To observe and study representative examples of elementary, secondary and teacher training educational facilities in Japan. In particular, to study the relationship between USOM and Ministry of Education; the financial structure for education; adaption of functional education to universal education; vocational education practices; general administration and supervision of instruction; schoolhouse construction, community schools and lay participation, secondary education and student activities, and teacher education.

They will confer with Ministry of Education officials and tour the school facilities of Japan. Much emphasis will be placed on the financial structure and system of taxation; next of importance is the general administration and supervision of instruction, and thirdly, school house construction. The tour is designed to secure information which will be useful to the Ministry of Education in the areas mentioned above.
